

The Ram (Genesis 22:1-19)

The Ram signifies Christ and the covenant. We all desire to go in the depth of prayer. That is why we desire to conquer all problems that we face and to have true victory without any worries. And for that to take place, you must be able to hold onto Christ and ask the covenant to which that becomes the answer to your life. And through the promise of the Christ, you will be able to enjoy the spiritual mystery that God gives to you. Whoever maybe, if they live this life, they will be raised as the spiritual summits. It does not only extend only within this spiritual summit, but that is realistically taking place their lives and connects this skills and summit. And that appears in your reality which it influences all that is why it becomes the culture summit. Compared to the numbers of Israelites to proper nations, they were small number. However, they received tremendous evidence. And Moses became the spiritual summit in which he was able to surpass all things the kings had. I hope that we will all live this life as well. The most fundamental thing that you must do is to build an altar. With diligence and sincere heart, you must be able to give worship to God. You must pray, confess the covenant, and hold to the covenant. And you must align your life to world evangelization that God desires the most. Christ is our personal covenant, and the goal of Christ is our life mission and goal that God has given to us. The reason why Christ dies on the cross was to save many. This is the commission for who have been called by God. That is why our commission is especially important. Rightfully so, God will bless those who fight the spiritual battle and hold to the covenant. God will block all the hinders of Satan and even if there are problems that you face, God will overturn all for you. Satan will do all that he can do to block you, however, there will be great doors that will be opened. We must be the ones who possess commission from God. You must hold to heavenly mandate that God has given to you, and when you hold to, then you will rightfully be victorious. Satan can never defeat you. 1. The Ram

The first point that we will look at is the ram. Gen 22 records the last story of Abraham. The main topic of it is the ram. Even after his incident, Abraham continued to live. In Gen 25, His wife Sarah passed away, that is why he had a new wife. And the new wife bore him 6 sons. And he lived 175 years more after that. He continued to live 50 years after that, however, God ends the story regarding Abraham in Gen 22. This is a particularly important message. Even though he continues to live, I will not continue his story because I do not

need to speak of Abraham anymore and I have finished all the messages through Abraham's life. God concludes Abraham's story written in the Bible through Isaac in which there was a ram that dies for him. And the goal of the bible is to speak of Christ. Why did God call Abraham? To make him to testify of Christ through his life. Why did God call Joseph? To make him to speak of Christ. Why did God call Moses and apostle Paul? To make them speak Jesus is the Christ. So, today's main topic is regarding the ram. Abraham's faith was tremendous. And Isaac knew it all what was taking place, but he obeyed, that is tremendous. But the main point was the ram. We must have faith and obey God's word. But the covenant is Christ. The moment Abraham received the word to give his son as a sacrificial offering, he was never suspicious of it. In verse 3, it says, Abraham rose early in the morning, saddled his donkey to go to the mountain. This is not just average faith that anyone can have. God's fundamental topic regarding this incident is to prove that Abraham's faith regarding the ram. And because Abraham prepared to kill his son as a sacrificial offering, that is why the angel screamed and calls him, "Abraham, Abraham!" in verse 11. The angel tells him to stop. In Hebrews 11:19, it says, "He considered that God was able to even raise him from the dead, from which, figuratively speaking, he did receive him back." Abraham had his Son when he was 100 years old. He thought it was impossible to have a son, however, God has given him a son. And at that age, Sarah was not able to bear a son, however, God has given him a son. I believe that Abraham was astonished and shocked, and he would have never forgotten this incident. It was Abraham's confession and faith that God was the one who has given me a son of old age, that is why God is the one who will do all things for me. In verse 7, Isaac asked his Father, "where is a lamb for a burnt offering?" and Abraham responded to him. "God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son." I believe that because he was able to see the answer in the age of 100 years old, he surely had the faith that God is going to do everything for all things. He surely had the faith. The fact is that God is the one who has given me the son at incredibly old age that is why even though God will kill the son, God will save him. This was Abraham's faith, so without any second guess, he was able to put into action. It is truly outstanding. And Isaac's faith was very tremendous as well. He could have run away before he had tied him up, then he will never get caught. Isaac was in his teen, and Abraham was over 100 years old. How can his father catch after him? But Isaac did not run away. He simply stayed put even though he clearly knew what his father was doing. God wants to speak of eternal sacrifice and the covenant which is the ram. The ram was prepared instead of his son. Christ has died for our behalf. We should have died for our own sins and curses, but it is Jesus who has died on our behalf. It is truly outstanding. If you truly come to this answer, then you will be liberated

from all be able to have conquest. You will have true liberation from all things. In your past, future, and concern will all be conquered at the very moment. That is who Christ who died on your behalf and the one God has prepared. It was God who had prepared the ram. I believe that Isaac may have many thoughts through this incident that he faced. And he would have never forgotten it for the ram saved his life. That is when Isaac came to the answer through the ram. How do you think his life became? To be honest, Gen 26 is the only Bible that records Isaac's story. There are 10 chapters that records Abraham's life. And regarding for Joseph as well. But for Isaac itself, it just ends with 1 chapter. Because there was no other incident. He has already come to the answer of Christ, that is why there is no more story regarding Isaac's life. And he later became such a prosperous man. So, the Lord will provide all things that is why you will never be perished. He has already prepared someone who will die on your behalf. You will never die. That is the message that God has given to you today. You must enjoy this truth. He has completed all for you. You must have faith just like Abraham. You must never be shaken like Isaac. You must never assume. You must put the word into action just like Abraham did. You will come to the answer when you have faith. When you deeply enjoy this truth, you will be able to always have victory and conquer all things. May you the blessing upon to you enjoy the covenant of Christ. But Satan will continuously attack your faith.

2. The Gates of the Enemies.

The second point that we will look at is the gates of the enemies. God's promise is within the covenant. And this promise is your commission. The promise is the ram. Along with the ram, there is God's promise. It speaks of salvation. And it says that "You shall possess the gates of the enemies." And it says, "The gates of enemies never prevail against you." And in gen 22:17, it speaks of the ram and the promises that He has given. It says, "I will surely multiply your offspring as the stars of heaven and as the sand that is on the seashore. And your offspring shall possess the gate of his enemies." It means you will conquer. And verse 18, "In your offspring all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed my voice." Offspring signifies Abraham's descendant, but also it speaks about Christ. That is why it is singular. It also signifies many people. It says that through Christ, they will receive and be blessed. And it says that you shall possess the gates of his enemies. This is God's promise to those who hold onto Christ as the covenant. When you enjoy Christ, you gain the spiritual power within you. You will have peace, victory, confidence, and you will be able to have a positive outlook within future. This will take place for you. This spiritual power also influences the physical environment. Your answers will come to you, and your thoughts and your environment will be changed. If this continues, you will be

victorious and successful. That is how you can conquer all your environment. You will be able to conquer your life and all. We are fighting the war that has already been the won. It is Christ who had crushed the serpent's head. That is why we must confess Jesus is my Christ every day. This is called 'the spiritual summit'. All healings will take place within those who do this. By doing so, the Remnant movement will arise as well. God is using us for world evangelization. God has called us. It is God's absolute plan for you. It was God's absolute plan for Israelites to go inside of the land of Canaan. However, many people who were suspicious, and they were not able to enter the land of Canaan. They all died in the wilderness. Joshua and Caleb were simply believed in God. They had faith and follow God. And when they look at the past, God was able to split the Red Sea for them. In the wilderness, God provided them meals for them from heaven. And our church prayer topic is to save America, Latin America, Remnants, and People of 237 nations. This is God's will. It is not you who will do it, it is God who will do it. And if it is true that the Red Sea was split into half, God can do these works even now. He has time schedule for all His works. There is authority within that. No one can block it. That is why you must enjoy the covenant and live for world evangelization. The parent who is raising his/her children like this is an incredibly wise parent. So, parents, really think about it. Why do you want to send your child/children to prestigious school? Is it truly for world evangelization? If the parent is not wise, then the child will suffer that is why, parents, you must change your thoughts. The bible is the life direction that we must follow. You must live this life, then you will conquer all things. And not even this, all things must be connected to 237. Those who live their lives for 237 will never perish. Your fundamental foundation must be Christ and You must live your life heading toward world evangelization, 237. And you must build an altar. Then everything in your life will be finished. God is saying if you live like Abraham and Isaac, then I will not give you any problems. God is also saying, "If you face any problem, then I will overturn it for you." This is the conclusion of the Bible. In Matthew 6:33, God says that "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you." But many believers do not live this life. They are seeking the things of the world. That is incorrect. If that is wrong, what will happen? Then you will be at loss. That is why you must change your thoughts. Christ is working upon us even now. He will give us and allow us to possess the gates of the enemies. We are the people who possess this authority.
