

Resurrection of Christ

John 20:1-10

You believe that there is no such thing as coincidence in the world. Everything that happens in the world is all according to God's absolute plan and govern. Psalms 139:2-4 states, "You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar. You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways. Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O LORD, you know it altogether". If it is God who knows everything about you in real time, there is something you must do throughout your entire life. You must edit the things of God to yourself. You must edit and plan God's desire for your life. The day Moses received God's word in Mt. Horeb, he completely edited and imprinted his life with the things of God. Likewise, it is the same when God has commanded Moses to go to the land he will show him and when God commanded Apostle Paul to testify the gospel to the Gentiles, kings, and Jews. You do many works and they are important to you, but the most important work is to have the things of God within you as your own. Also, your life must be of God's life. May you confirm this truth once again and be a time to examine your life once again. God's ultimate goal is to testify the gospel to save many.

1. Resurrection of Christ

- 1) It was a prophesied work and is a definite work. He is God, for there is no such thing as death to such a kind. So if he dies, there must be a clear reason for this. The reason was because He died in your stead.
- 2) However, His death and resurrection was so important to mankind. There would be no hope for mankind if He did not die and resurrect. Mankind would be living day by day moving closer to hell.
- 3) But Christ arose. This is evidence in the fact that he is God and is evidence that He is the covenant that can bring you out of the curse of death. He proves that He is the answer to mankind's biggest problem.
- 4) Therefore, Christ who has died on the cross has resurrected and is still living. These two words are so important. Because He resurrected, He is working even now. This means that when you hold Him as your covenant, the same works will arise. This is another message given through the resurrection.
- 5) John 19:30 states, "It is finished," which means that He has completed the covenant. Therefore, if you are inside of this covenant, you will receive the eternal right to receive salvation and be freed from curses to crush Satan.
- 6) This Lord resurrected to show that this covenant is the answer that can bind all of Satan's authority. So, it speaks about how Christ's resurrection completes the explanation of what the covenant is. If Christ had not resurrected, the explanation of the covenant of the cross would not be complete.
- 7) Also, the Lord showed His resurrection to his disciples for 40 days to show that His covenant is complete, and He ascended as the disciples watched (Acts 1:9-11). He explained perfectly and showed what the covenant is.
- 8) What should you do with this completed covenant? It's so clear. You must believe in this covenant. You must believe that Christ's death and bloodshed truly set you free from curses, that it truly bound the authority of Satan, that it overcame the curse of death, and that you are also resurrected.
- 9) Also, you must hold onto it as your covenant, confess it, and enjoy it. You must open your eyes and discover it. So, you must be victorious because you must become the witness. May you believe that these types of blessings will come if you enjoy Christ. It's simple. You just need to enjoy Christ.

2. What He Did After His Resurrection

- 1) What the Lord did after His resurrection is still important. It will be an important reference in your life. The risen Lord went looking for His disciples, comforted them, and showed that He

had risen. The first person to meet the resurrected Christ was Mary called Magdalene, who suffered from 7 demons (Luke 8:2).

- 2) After that, the Lord appeared several times to the places where the disciples were gathered and blessed peace. He also proved to Thomas, who was doubtful, by placing his hands on His side to prove the resurrection (John 20:27).
- 3) Acts 1:3 states, "He presented himself alive to them after his suffering by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God." He personally testified that He is alive again and gave you promises and commands. These are the 4 resurrection messages.
- 4) In Matthew 28:16-20, Jesus said to make disciples of all nations and that He will be with you always, to the end of the age. In Mark 16:15-20, Jesus said to go into all the world, proclaim the gospel to the sick, and when the disciples go share the gospel the Lord worked with them and confirmed the message by accompanying signs.
- 5) The conclusion of Luke is Acts 1:8. "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." And in John 21:15-18, He said "feed my lambs," three times. This is a message to raise the next generation.
- 6) This is summarized as the 237, Healing, Summit, and the covenant. This is the commission that every believer should receive. Also, this must be the answer to your life. Even those who run a business, Christ must be the answer to the business. The evangelist should not have anything more to say and nothing more to do than this.
- 7) This applies to the church too. Many work diligently in their respected fields, but must work for the sake of this. Believers have already received the answer. These must be the answer to your life: resurrected Christ, the Christ who is with you even now, and the 4 resurrection messages.
- 8) This is what God has given you. This must be edited and imprinted in you, and you must become a person of this. This is the person of God. This resurrection message is God's wish in this age. There is a lot of training and messages to do this right.
- 9) May you have a week of imprinting to set your mind right and put your life in this direction. Living like this is the answer to your life. This is the end of what you're going to do. The life of faith is to put your heart here, enjoy Christ every day, and live holding on to the covenant. Then, everything will be done according to God's will. This is a believer's way of life.
