Acts 18:1-11

- 4) 18:6 Silas and Timothy went to Macedonia.
 - (1) Silas and Timothy's ministry in Thessalonica and Berea.
 - (2) They joined Apostle Paul in Corinth.
 - (3) In Corinth, they met Priscilla and Aquila.
- 5) 18:5 Paul was occupied with the word that Christ was Jesus.

3. Other disciples

- 1) 7: A worshiper of God, Titius Justus.
- 2) 8: Crispus, the ruler of the synagogue and his entire household believed.
- 3) Many Corinthians
- 4) 9-10: Teaching the word of God
- 5) 11: A year and sixth month
