

# The Mizpah Movement

1 Samuel 7:1-11

God does all things according to the Word. He first gives the Word and fulfills it accordingly. Therefore, the life of those who make the resolution of the Word is simple and will see evidence. That Word becomes a great turning point and becomes the work of recreation that completely overturns one's life. As Moses was being breastfed, his mother relayed the entire story of Genesis to him. Later on, Moses received the covenant and word of that age which was to enter into the land of Canaan. After this, the works of recreation took place in Moses' life. No one shook the world as much as Moses. However, it was not Moses alone. Works of complete recreation took place for all of the people that received and held onto the word of that age. Joshua, Caleb, Jethro, the elders, and prostitute Rahab all lived a historical life. Matthew 16:3 states, "And in the morning, 'It will be stormy today, for the sky is red and threatening.' You know how to interpret the appearance of the sky, but you cannot interpret the signs of the times". Christ is the sign of the age. In the age of Moses, the sign of that age was the promised land of Canaan. In Noah's age it was the Ark and in Apostle Paul's age it was the Gentiles which later on became world evangelization. The message of this age is contained in the 4 resurrection messages that Jesus gave before He ascended to heaven. This is the covenant that you must hold to until the day of the second coming of Jesus. When you receive this word as the word of this age then just like Joshua, Caleb, Jethro, the elders, and prostitute Rahab you will live a life of recreation.

## 1. **Mizpah movement**

- 1) Today's bible passage is about the Mizpah Movement. The ark of the covenant was lodged by the Kiribath-jearim in the house of Abinadab for about twenty years. By God's plan, the people of Israel lamented after the Lord. (Verse 2)
- 2) During this time, Samuel had started a movement of repentance in all of Israel so people followed his words. He states to "put away the foreign gods and the Ashtaroath from among you and direct your heart to the Lord and serve him only, and he will deliver you out of the hand of the Philistine." (Verse 3)
- 3) As recorded in Verse 6, the people of Israel gathered in Mizpah to fast and repent to the Lord, however it states in Verse 7 that the Philistines went up against the Israelites just as God had planned. That is why the Israelites begged Samuel to cry out to the Lord.
- 4) Samuel took a nursing lamb and offered it to the Lord and he cried out to Him. (Verse 9) The Lord thundered with a mighty sound that day against the Philistines as they were defeated before Israel. (Verse 10)
- 5) Verse 13 states that the hand of the Lord was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel. Verse 14 states, "The cities that the Philistines had taken from Israel were restored to Israel, from Ekron to Gath, and Israel delivered their territory from the hand of the Philistines. There was peace also between Israel and Amorites."
- 6) This is a rough timeline of the Mizpah movement. Firstly, they put away the other gods and repented before the Lord. Next, they must have restored the covenant of God amongst Israel. They were able to do this by offering the nursing lamb as a whole burnt offering.
- 7) God completely destroyed their opponent nation and restored all of the land that was once taken from them. Peace was restored amongst the Israelites and the Amorites, and the hand of God was against the Philistines for as long as Samuel lived.
- 8) This movement must arise in America and go to the ends of Latin America. Surely, this is God's desire. This movement must arise in our church and for this to happen, it must begin within yourself.
- 9) You must put away your idols and repent as you return back to God and restore the covenant. God will then restore everything that was taken when you lost the covenant and will protect you from your opponents.
- 10) Your life will be at peace and God will protect you from all things because this covenant lives in you. God's desire will be fulfilled through you. Samuel went on a circuit every year as he judged

all of the cities of Israel. (Verse 16) He relayed the Word and allowed it to enter into the people's lives through his judgement. You must also do this Word Movement.

- 11) Verse 17 states, "Then he would return to Ramah, for his home was there, and there also he judged Israel. And he built there an altar to the Lord." He passed this onto future generations and also did the Remnant Movement.
- 12) The three-day weekend represents a sign post of this important age. May you never forget this and follow the Word. God's desire for this age is represented through words such as culture, concentration, and training. The works of recreation will occur when you enter into the Word.

## 2. **The one who has the covenant**

- 1) God blocked the enemies for Samuel because he had the covenant. Also, God restore the lands that was taken away and many Israelites repented and returned to the Lord. God blocked the enemies to which they lived in peace.
- 2) Through you, the family line and the church will be revived. Through you, who has the covenant, the start of the Gospel movement of America that leads to the ends of Latin America.
- 3) To be that one person is your lifelong covenant. Because of you who places Latin America in their heart will be used to revive it. If you hold to this covenant, then you would want to live life for the sake of the covenant.
- 4) It is Hannah that conceived Samuel. The female church officer, Hannah, was very important person in that time. If historical doors are open for the Gospel movement, then it will be the same as the work of recreation. For the one church that holds to the Gospel will be a historical blessing.
- 5) The next step for missions must be reached in Latin America through the disciples that were raised. It is the 5,000 people groups movement of Latin America. It is God's desire to do the Gospel movement in all of Latin America through the 100 teams movement.
- 6) Because we need a secure financial situation, we are waiting for the time schedule for finance. We are waiting for that one person that can support the finances for Latin American missions. That one person that will receive the economy of light to carry out the Remnant Movement for historical Gospelization in America.
- 7) These words hold great meaning. They were able to restore all things that were taken from them and were protected from other nations because of Samuel. When war broke out, God handled it through His miracles and the ark of the covenant was returned back to them.
- 8) You must live the life that witnesses miracles that occur through the covenant. You must become a witness that experiences continuous answers and the church must be used for this.
- 9) These answers are received through the Word that you receive as you restore the covenant. When you receive the Word, it will be fulfilled. May it be a day in which you receive the Word.
