All Things Work Together for Good

Romans 8:26-30

The Word that was given last week is the answer to avert the plagues amidst your life. God desired Daniel to build an altar before Him. This altar symbolizes the precious blood of Christ and this removes the disaster within your life. If you are facing hardships right now, may you once again hold to the covenant. Christ has the authority that liberates you from all curses and overturns all problems into blessings. There is no exception when it comes to God's authority. All problems, fate, and curses will be overturned into blessings. The covenant given to you is the complete covenant, so it is a covenant in which nothing is impossible. There may be times where things don't take place, but if you are holding onto the covenant failures will be overturned or it will become a platform for other answers. Nothing is useless, even all of your failures will change into important answers. All of your failures are part of God's process for His final and complete answer for you. May this become the answer in your heart once again. Your life will become a masterpiece. The Kingdom of Heaven now belongs to those who commit violence. (Matthew 11:12) This means that when you make up your mind, pray, and hold to the covenant, you will receive an answer. Now, it's all up to you. However, you must keep in mind that you must start with the covenant. May the blessing of receiving an answer be upon you.

1. All things work together for good

- 1) Today's bible passage is such a precious word for believers. As you live, you will face many different types of problems. During that time, God makes all things work together for good. You must be grateful as this is an uplifting word.
- 2) The message from last week stated that the reason for the power of averting all fare and curses being inside of building the altar is because of God's will. God makes all things work together for good for those who are called by Him.
- 3) How could Joseph have become the governor of Egypt and meet the king if he was not accused of no wrongdoing to be sent to jail after being sold as a slave?
- 4) These examples exist not only in the Bible, but around you in the church as well. This is why God is a God of love and grace to make all things work together for good.
- 5) The mystery to enjoy all things for the good is the Gospel. Disasters will be averted when you build an altar and your curses will be transformed into blessings. You must all enjoy this fact, but must particularly hold onto the covenant when you are in hardship.
- 6) You must come to the conclusion that the God who has called you will make all things work together for good and for you to build the altar of your life.
- 7) That altar must be your bartizan that works to break down Satan with God's authority for it must become the kingdom of God. You must never forget that God told David that he did not have to do anything else, but needed to build an altar.
- 8) When the mystery of prayer of enjoying the altar becomes your bartizan, you will be able to conquer Satan who will kneel down before you. May you become a historical witness that breaks down all disasters. God will make all things work together for good just as He promised.

2. The one who connect with God's will

- 1) You must connect with God's will. That way, you will not have trouble in life and will not waste your time going down the wrong path. Those who connect with God's will can leave behind the masterpiece of conquest.
- 2) Daniel knew the reason, resolved in his heart and lived his life. In the midst of crises, he did not cease to pray. Hannah discovered God's reason as she prayed and received Samuel as God's promise along with three sons and two daughters.
- 3) The age of Jochebed with a time of crises. It was an age that the Egyptian king commanded to kill all the Israelites sons. In the midst of tribulations Jochebed resolved in her heart to fight against

Satan and sent Moses to the palace. It was not to flee from Egypt, but she prayed as she planned to send Moses to the princess palace.

- 4) Jochebed's plan matched God's will to which the princess received Moses, who was the son of the Hebrews and had his mother nurse him. Jochebed resolved in her heart to stake her life as she held to the covenant and relayed the book of Genesis to Moses as she nursed him in prayer. She was a committed worker who had assurance that it must be only the Gospel to her son, Moses. She was a woman who had the bartizan of relaying the Gospel to the next generation.
- 5) Jochebed knew she did not have much time, so she sincerely prayed. Moses who was over the age of forty was reminded of the book of Genesis that was relayed to him when his mother nursed him. Moses was able to write the book of Genesis that is recorded in the Bible. What was Jochebed's prayer and resolution? You must ask yourself as well.
- 6) Age by age, there were many precious individuals and figures stated in the church history that connected to God's will. There will be many church officers and remnants that will be greatly used by God in the upcoming ages.
- 7) God's will is very simple and straightforward. It is to enjoy Jesus Christ and to testify Jesus Christ to the world. There is nothing else except for this. Your life must be restored through the enjoyment of Jesus Christ. You must relay it to the world, so Satan's kingdom will crumble and God's kingdom will be established. It is to relay the bartizan of light to the world that is filled with darkness.
- 8) When the Gospel is testified, it will brighten the dark places. Your thoughts, heart, and circumstances will brighten up when the Gospel is testified. No one can block the light for this is the absolute bartizan. It will definitely become brighter. Only thing left is to become brighter through the Gospel. May you receive this answer. May it be restored in you as you stand as a witness.
- 9) You will receive grace when you connect with God's heart and will. The representative grace is that you will no longer be conflicted with God. There are many times you are so desperate that you fervently pray, but that will soon be resolved.
- 10) You will naturally pray to God. The wall between yourself and God will no longer exist and you will draw closer to God. Many things will take place as long as you connect with God's desire and His heart.
- 11) Daniel was used to save Babylon because he connected with God's will. God allowed that to take place because Daniel connected with God's will. It will take place for you as well.
- 12) When you pray holding to the covenant in the midst of joyful times, painful times, and difficult times, God will be at work for His good will. This is the rightful blessing that will come to those who receive much grace and connect with God's will. May you have faith in this as you to the covenant. May the grace be upon you to build the altar. As you deeply build the altar, may it be the bartizan that will save the world.
