The Evangelism to Restore

Acts 16:11-15

You must live your life as an evangelist. There is authority in evangelism. Anyone who blocks evangelism will face death. This is the evangelist's authority (Matthew 10:14-15). The important mission of this age is to restore Biblical evangelism. The content is important, but the strategy is important as well and must be received as the covenant. It speaks of the 7 journeys. From Caesarea Philippi to Rome.

1. The direction of evangelism that God desires.

- 1) The evangelism that is led by the Holy Spirit. - The evangelism that first receives answers before heading out to the field.
- 2) The importance of prayer
- 3) The covenant does not allow one to be discouraged when faced with closed doors.
- 4) Evangelism is God's unchanging desire.

2. Disciple evangelism

- 1) The one who already serves God. - The worthy one (Matthew 10:11) - Stay there
- 2) 15: Urged to stay
- 3) Matthew 13:8 Good soil – Fruits – Church in Philippi
- 4) Preparation for the spiritual battle - Base
- 5) The works arose after - There is one person like this in each region.

3. The blessing of the prayer that holds to the covenant.

- 1) The meeting with the prepared disciples - A coincidental opportunity
- 2) The one who receives the Word.
- 3) Heart, thoughts, and desire - The one who connects - Lifelong
- 4) Absolute disciple - Bartizan - For the age

4. Conclusion

- 1) Evangelism is done by the covenant and prayer. Also, it must be set in God's direction.
- 2) The authority of the covenant opens a new door for the doors that are closed.
- 3) The person of the absolute covenant does everything by the Word. Joseph, Moses, and Paul were all like this.
