God's Infinite Promises

2 Corinthians 1:15-22

God's promise for life and salvation is simple. Anyone who knows and believes in the fundamental principle will be saved. Those who believe and enjoy the content as they confess it will see God's work upon them. When you continuously do it, the time schedule will come that will lead your life. All you have to do is follow it. Mankind are creations, so they must live by this principle. If you live by this principle, you will overcome problems, receive answers in advance, and conquer the future. Most people who are facing severe spiritual problems such as suicide, murder, and serious matters are in a spiritual state that is far from this principle. If you return to the Gospel, then God will you. The Gospel must be restored in you and you must enjoy the Gospel. Prayer will set you free from curses. May you be victorious and conquer everything.

1. God's infinite promises

- 1) There is no limitation for God's promises. 2 Corinthians 1:19 "For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, whom we proclaimed among you, Silvanus and Timothy and I, was not Yes and No, but in him it is always Yes."
- 2) Everything and anything is possible for Christ. He is the Almighty God and no one can ever block Him. He has His set plan and it will never change. Therefore, there it is always and forever Yes in Jesus Christ.
- 3) He is always positive and never negative. He allows victory and conquest in all things. Therefore, everything in Him is absolute.
- 4) 2 Corinthians 1:20 "For all the promises of God find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory." God's promise is always possible and will be done. It will be fulfilled.
- 5) It will take place and all you have to utter is Amen to God for his glory. God's promises will always be fulfilled.
- 6) However, there is a condition and that is "in Christ". In Christ, all the promises that are given by God will be fulfilled. Whatever it may be and until the end it will be done. God's promise is for you to conquer your life and world, enjoy the blessing of the throne, and save the universe by breaking down the ruler of the kingdom of this air. It is a Yes in Christ.
- 7) Apostle Paul is an amazing figure. Through the Bible passage, you can get a glimpse of Apostle Paul's spiritual realm. 2 Corinthians 1:17 "Was I vacillating when I wanted to do this? Do I make my plans according to the flesh, ready to say "Yes, yes" and "No, no" at the same time?"
- 8) This is a tremendous confession from the Apostle Paul. He states, "Do I make my plans according to the flesh, ready to say "Yes, yes" and "No, no" at the same time?" It shows that he is a man of prayer and he was centered on the answers from God. He was a man who waited and prayed until he received the sure answer from God which is why he states he never said yes and no at the same time.
- 9) Apostle Paul proved that he was a man who did not make decisions according to his heart. He states that he did not vacillate or make plans according to his flesh. He never made any decisions without receiving God's answer first. He never did any of that.
- 10) He states that God's answer and will is unchanging to which it will be done, so he never uttered no. He acted because he first received God's answer. He continued no matter how much Satan attacked him. It is because God's will will be done no matter what. It is because it is God's will. That's what Apostle Paul meant.
- 11) He truly is a renowned figure. He was a true servant of the Lord who did not go visit the church according to his own heart because he did not receive answers to prayer. It is constantly being stated in the messages that as you listen to the message the covenant will come in your heart for you to enjoy as you wait for God's kingdom to be upon you to make the challenge. It means the same as well.
- 12) You may have read the Bible passage and not been touched by it in the past. You may not have much thought about the amazing life and state of Apostle Paul. One may lack to accurately know Jesus Christ and they cannot take the next step in their spiritual life. It may be because your spiritual eyes are dimmed. If one is not able to grasp a hold of Jesus Christ then how can their spiritual eyes open to

take the next step? Many aspects of training are contained in the Gospel. Your spiritual eyes must open to uncover the unheard Word and the meanings behind it.

- 13) Apostle Paul's confession is something you must deeply meditate on. Many Biblical figures lived the same life as this. Moses, Joseph, and David lived this life as well. There were sins and mistakes that they made, but they never lived a life that was astray. May this blessing be upon your life and prayer to have this spiritual realm.

2. **The way**

- 1) How can you live a spiritual life like the Apostle Paul? How can you be a person who moves according to the answers that are given by God? How much are you a person of the prayer that connects with God's heart? How important is it to you to preach the Gospel? These are important questions to ask yourself.
- 2) You must confirm that it is always a Yes in Jesus Christ. You must confirm the life of the covenant that is in Jesus Christ as you see the evidence, answers, and works that are bound to take place. If you continuously do this, you will confirm in your heart that it is always a Yes in God's promises and there is no limitation whatsoever.
- 3) You will continuously receive the important answers from God. Then, you will make the same confession as Apostle Paul. From the start, God's promise will and always be done. All answers are contained in Jesus Christ and it is promised for the sake of Jesus Christ.
- 4) Not only is the confession of the three offices of Jesus Christ the answer, but it the fundamental to all things that arise in the world. You must receive the Word through the pulpit message and many training messages. If you pray, God will grant you the Word and you will receive guidance from the Word as answers will continuously be given to you.
- 5) If you are like the 7 Remnants whose spiritual eyes were opened to God's desire and connected with God's heart, then you will receive the historical answers. An average woman like Hannah became the historical figure of that age. Someone like Rahab, who was looked down upon, became the fourth-generation grandmother of King David.
- 6) Life will be overturned. Also, this is the answer. If you confess Jesus Christ, hold to the covenant, give worship, and attend training as you receive the Word and follow it, then your spiritual eyes will open to have God's desire for that age to be yours.
- 7) What is left is the realm of conquering all things as you wait. When you conquer, many lives will be saved and you will give your life to God. God will bless your next generations and allow your family line to stand as a great witness.
- 8) For this amazing life to take place, the start is for you to have the personal time to enjoy Jesus Christ. You will receive all things through this. As a result, you will confess that God's promises are and will be fulfilled.
- 9) It is God's infinite promise. There is no limitation and is unchanging. It will take place for it is absolute power. These amazing promises have been given to you. May you confirm the covenant as you deeply hold to it and be the one who enjoys Jesus Christ for 24 hour.
