

Through the Promise

It's a new year and may it be a year of new hopes and covenants. The covenants we must hold on to this year are the Temple of Light, the Economy of Light, and the Guidepost of Light. May it be a year of prayer as a church centered on these covenants. May we be blessed with the answer of team ministry evangelism, to be in charge of one nation to save South America, and the age of the three-day weekend. If the Word comes in and becomes a covenant, it will surely be fulfilled and an important step toward Rome. Team ministry evangelism is the foundation of Biblical evangelism. It is two people working as a team to find one disciple. Naturally, there will be a lot of prayer and complete Holy Spirit guidance. Therefore, there should be no haste, and there should be deep heart-to-heart prayer with God first. Then we will surely have successful evangelism and become evangelists who conquer and enjoy evangelism.

1. Through promise

1. The main idea of today's passage is that salvation is not by works of the Law but only by God's promise. At the time, many argued that because they were transitioning from the Law to the Gospel, they should keep the Law while believing in Christ.
2. Paul always emphasized Christ, faith, and promises. Today, he does it again, using the family of Abraham as an example. Abraham had two sons, Ishmael by his servant Hagar and Isaac by his wife Sarah.
3. The scripture compares Hagar, who corresponds to the present Jerusalem who claimed the Law they received at Mount Sinai in Arabia, and the Law of the day. Sarah, to the Jerusalem above, is free, which holds the promises of God. The scripture also describes Sarah as free, and Hagar as enslaved to the Law.
4. Naturally, then, Ishmael is categorized as the one without promise, born after the flesh, while Isaac is described as the descendant of promise, born according to the promise of God, as found in Genesis 18:10. Thus, through the two sons and two mothers of Abraham's family, a clear distinction is made between the Law and the Gospel.
5. But the Law is also the Gospel, and that's why the Lord said, "Not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished". They were caught up in what they were told not to do, and their eyes were blind to the blood of the promise, which is the heart of the Law. So, they became servants of the Law and turned the Gospel into a religion. But if they had lived by the blood of the covenant, they would have been like Noah, Abraham, and Moses.
6. The same is true of the 10 Commandments. The Gospel is that God will bless you if you keep them. But most people don't interpret it this way. They don't have eyes on the Gospel because they don't have the Gospel. If they had the Gospel, they would interpret the world, the Bible, people, and events through the lens of the Gospel.
7. And you will liberate and conquer yourself from everything in the world, it's so obvious. Galatians 4:27 states the conclusion that there must be a promise. Without God's promise, no matter how many things there are, they are useless, and everything is according to the promise. God promises everything first and then fulfills His promise. He does this with everything in the world, and there is no doubt about salvation. Once again, may you be blessed to take God's word of promise as a covenant.

2. The one who resolved in their heart

1. As we close out one year and begin a new one, may you have the grace to resolve in your heart. Those who have the covenant can set it in their heart. You can just go along with the Gospel because you like it but resolving it in your heart is a bit different.
2. First, the spiritual authority is different in the heart. Because the determination is different, the spiritual battle is different. You go to the end because you have resolved in your heart, and it doesn't matter if there are difficulties. There are no conditions or reasons. This is the heart and mentality of Nothing, Nobody. There are many people like this in the Bible and they all rose above all circumstances and reasons.
3. He surpassed the words of others. It didn't matter that he was persecuted, that his brothers tried to kill him, that he was sold into slavery. Even though committed no sin and was sent to prison, he was not bothered by it. Nothing became a scar to him because it wasn't his will, but God's will for him.
4. When the Word comes in and becomes a covenant to you, and that covenant becomes the reason you resolve in your heart, then things are bound to take place. If this takes place, then you will live above the world. You live in this world, but you are not of the world. You will transcend, conquer, and be the pilgrim that is not bothered by anything.
5. We are the ones who set our heart to America and South America and the Remnant and of all nations. And this blessing comes to those who enjoy the Gospel, and in this way, eventually, when we get to 24, Satan will be on his knees before you. It's a matter of your pride, in a sense, to be in a spiritual battle against Satan. All the spiritual battle against Satan has already been defeated and he will be on his knees before you.
6. May you be the one who has set their hearts to save America, South America, Remnants, and all nations. In that, may you resolve your heart to receive the answer of team ministry evangelism, to oversee one nation in South America, and the age of the three-day weekend. May you pray for this throughout the year.
7. Jews are on Shabbat starting Friday evening. American culture is a culture to enjoy the weekend starting Friday evening. American culture is seized by drugs, mental illnesses, and demons. Who says Jewish culture is like the culture of America?
8. They're not centered on the Gospel, but they have kept their culture for 2000 years, and many interpret that they are in control of everything that matters in the world. The answer to raising children is to raise them according to the Bible, and the Jews are a clear testament to that. Now that you have the answer, you must do it, because nothing happens without doing it. Hold to the promise and live the life according to the promise. Then, you will be victorious, conquer all things, and live a life of a witness.
