

# If You Exalt Him

Proverbs 4:1-9

## 1. If you exalt Him

- 1) Proverbs 4:8 "Prize her highly, and she will exalt you; she will honor you if you embrace her. Proverbs 4:6 "Do not forsake her, and she will keep you; love her, and she will guard you."
- 2) Proverbs 4:1 "Hear, O sons, a father's instruction, and be attentive, that you may gain insight." A father's instruction will speak wisdom, and he who has wisdom will have understanding. 1 Corinthians 1:24 "Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God." Colossians 2:3 "In whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge."
- 3) Proverbs 4:5 "Get wisdom; get insight; do not forget, and do not turn away from the words of my mouth." You will gain insight. You will be wise and make the right judgment. You will receive the guidance of the Holy Spirit to make the right decision. Proverbs 4:6 states "Do not forsake her." Proverbs 4:7 "The beginning of wisdom is this: Get wisdom, and whatever you get, get insight."
- 4) It's an amazing statement, a spiritual proverb that cuts to the heart of the matter: enjoy Christ and you will gain the wisdom of God, and He will give you insight, and you will be led by the Holy Spirit. You get into trouble and make poor or muddled choices because you're not spiritually awakened.
- 5) The Bible passage is a proverb given to resolve the problem. It's an answer and a spiritual message that is aligned with the message of the entire Bible. The most fundamental reason to listen to the Word and worship is to reaffirm and imprint the answers God has given.
- 6) The answer is already set, it's never changing, it's never lacking in anything that needs to be added, and it's already complete and ready to be fulfilled whenever you enjoy it. It's complete and absolute blood of the promise. May you be blessed to see it again, conquer it in Christ, and be a witness to the ends of the earth.

## 2. Parent

- 1) Proverbs 4:4 "He taught me and said to me, "Let your heart hold fast my words; keep my commandments, and live." These are the words of his father, David, to Solomon. This is probably something that Solomon heard often in his life, and David was a man of answers enough to say this to his son.
- 2) Proverbs 4:1 "Hear, O sons, a father's instruction, and be attentive, that you may gain insight." These words appear to be speaking of King Solomon's experience. Knowing how important the Father's instruction is to your life, never disregard the Father's instruction and gain understanding. It appears to be a confession that within that instruction is God's understanding.
- 3) Children should listen to their parents; they will not lose anything by doing so. Parents will never say anything that will kill their children, but if their words are in line with God's desires and in the same direction as His Word, then their words will raise miracles in their lives, and they will need to keep saying them over and over again so that eventually it will be fulfilled in their lives.
- 4) We can see today that David was a precious parent in this regard. Proverbs 4:4 "Let your heart hold fast my words; keep my commandments, and live." It's a bold statement, a bold confession, with a very clear answer to his life.

- 5) You should be the one who has this answer. If you tell others to follow you because you have the answer to relay to them, then surely they will conquer their lives and all will be overturned. This is the witness. You should be able to say this to anybody who passes by.
- 6) 1 Corinthians 4:1 "This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God." This is the confession of the Apostle Paul, who saw himself as one chosen by God, and who would have confirmed it by the witnesses in the fields. It was not pride, but truth and gratitude.
- 7) Whoever enjoys Jesus Christ comes to this answer. Your life will be like David's and Paul's life. 100 and 1,000 years of answers will be upon you as a masterpiece. God will make your life of Rome evangelization and save the 237 nations.
